General journey information

Length: 200 metres (about 655 feet)

Time: 5 minutes (6-8 minutes if you have mobility difficulties or if the area is crowded)



Each picture includes a coloured time-bar to show you the distance completed so far



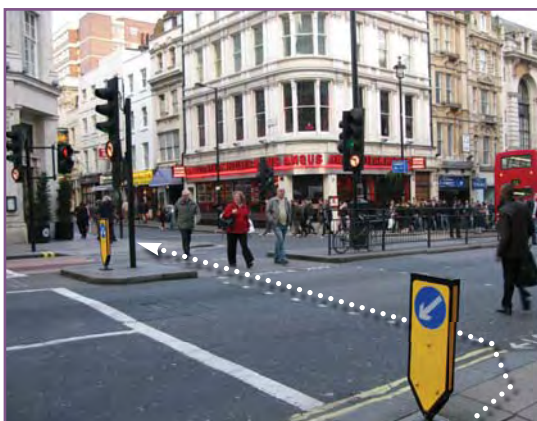

With Eros on your left, pass the Criterion Theatre on your right. Go along Coventry Street until you reach the first corner with the large horse statue fountain on the right.

Turn right into Haymarket Street (there is a downhill slope which gets steeper). Cross Jermyn Street and St James's Market Street. Continue to the corner of Norris Street.



3 of 5

Turn left and cross Haymarket.



4 of 5

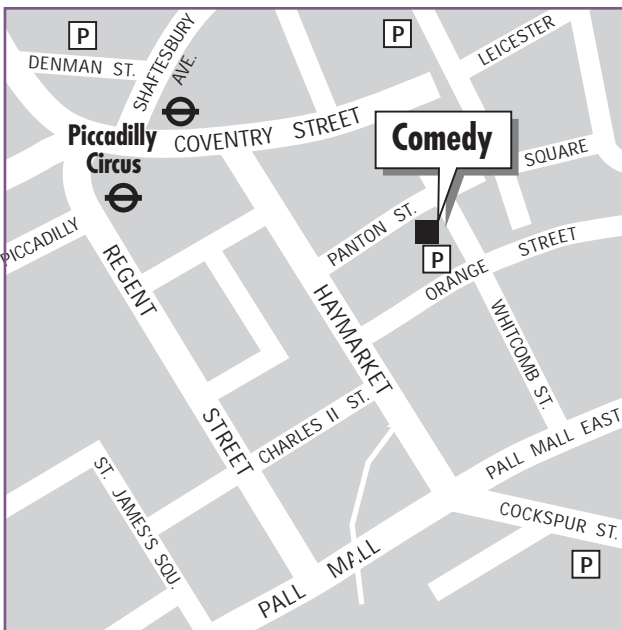
Turn right and cross Panton Street, and immediately turn left.

Continue along Panton Street for about 30 metres (about 98 feet) to the entrance of the Comedy Theatre. Ask here for assistance to the accessible entrance (around the corner to your right).

You have now reached the Comedy Theatre.
