

## Eros, Piccadilly Circus to the London Palladium

Eros Statue, Piccadilly Circus W1B 5RD

London Palladium, Argyll Street W1F 7TF



### General journey information

**Length:** 690 metres (about 2264 feet)

**Time:** 15-18 minutes (20-30 minutes if you have mobility difficulties or if the area is crowded)



Each picture includes a coloured time-bar to show you the distance completed so far



### 1 of 7

With your back to Eros and the Lillywhites building, look over to the neon signs of Piccadilly Circus. Cross Piccadilly Street to the large traffic island.



### 2 of 7

Turn right and cross Regent Street. Turn left under the arches to bus stop G and continue.



### 3 of 7

Continue around the curve of Regent Street, crossing Air Street and Glasshouse Street on your right.





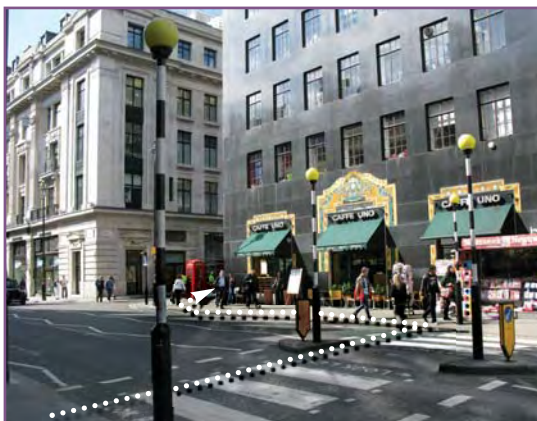
## 4 of 7

Cross Regent's Place and continue straight down Regent's Street. Cross Beak Street, Tenison Court and Foubert's Place on your right.



## 5 of 7

At the corner of Great Marlborough Street turn right. Cross Kingly Street and continue for about 12 metres (about 39 feet) to the crossing in front of the Liberty's store.



## 6 of 7

Cross Great Marlborough Street and turn left. At the first corner turn right into Argyll Street.



## 7 of 7

Continue down Argyll Street for another 40 metres (about 131 feet) to the steps of the London Palladium. Ask staff here for any assistance needed.

(Wheelchair users should arrive at 19:00 and will be escorted to the accessible entrance some distance behind theatre; those with mobility difficulties should arrive by 19:20 for assistance up the stairs).

**You have now reached the London Palladium.**
